Trip Itinerary

Day 1 Welcome to Baku- Panoramic Tour

- Arrival at Airport.
- Transfer from Airport to restaurant.
- Lunch.
- Accommodation in hotel.
- Free time.
- Assembly at lobby.
- Visit Highland Park Alley of Martyrs, The National Assembly- also transliterated as Milli Majlis and Flame towers- the tallest skyscraper in Baku.

• A walk through Baku Boulevard which stretches along a south-facing bay on the Caspian Sea. It traditionally starts at Freedom Square continuing west to the Old City and beyond. Interestingly, since 2012, the Yeni Bulvar (New Boulevard) has virtually doubled the length to 3.75 km.

Day 2 Baku City Tour

- Breakfast in Hotel
- Our tour program starts with the historical core of old city Baku- the capital of Azerbaijan.
- The Old City is the most ancient part of Baku, which is surrounded by walls.
- Lunch

• Explore the happening street of Nizami Street. The street runs through the city's downtown from west to east. It begins from Abdulla Shaig Street, in mountainous part of the city and ends at railroad bed on Sabit Orujov Street, near a monument to Shah Ismail Khatai in "Black City".

- Visit the charming "Heydar Aliyev Center" a 57,500 m building complex in Baku, known for its distinctive architecture and curved style that eschews sharp angles.

Day 3 Flame Tour

- Breakfast in Hotel.
- Tour starts with Ateshgah (Fire Worshippers Temple). Based on Persian and Indian inscriptions, the temple was used as a Hindu and Zoroastrian place of worship.
- Trip to "Fire Mountain "-"Yanardag" -a mountain on Absheron peninsula, 25 km from north of Baku. Yanar dag is a natural gas fire which blazes continuously on a hillside on the Absheron Peninsula on the Caspian Sea near Baku, the capital of Azerbaijan, which itself is known as the "land of fire."
- Lunch.
- Visit Bibi-Heybat Mosque- a historical mosque in Baku and is one of the major monuments of Islamic architecture in Azerbaijan.
- Shopping tour of Ganjlik Mall- the biggest Mall in Baku containing over 80 stores, big bowling halls, big movie halls, 3D cinema, Playground for children, Bravo supermarket, and VIP restaurants
- Dinner
- Back to hotel

Day 4 Gabala Tour

- Breakfast
- Move towards the north-west of Azerbaijan.
- Arrival.
- Lunch.

• Visit Tufandaq which offers cable car rides at any time of the year, skiing on the ski tracks of different difficulty level, ski training and ski school, catering service (cafe and restaurants), entertainment centers for kids, hotel and other services.

- Visit Nohur lake.
- Dinner.
- Back to Baku.
- Back to hotel.

- Overnight stay in Baku.

Details


Baku, the capital and commercial hub of Azerbaijan, is a low-lying city with coastline along the Caspian Sea. It is specifically famous for its medieval walled old city, which contains the Palace of the Shirvanshahs, a vast royal complex, and the iconic stone Maiden Tower. It's contemporary landmarks include the Zaha Hadid-designed Heydar Aliyev Center, and the Flame Towers- 3 pointed skyscrapers covered with LED screens.
